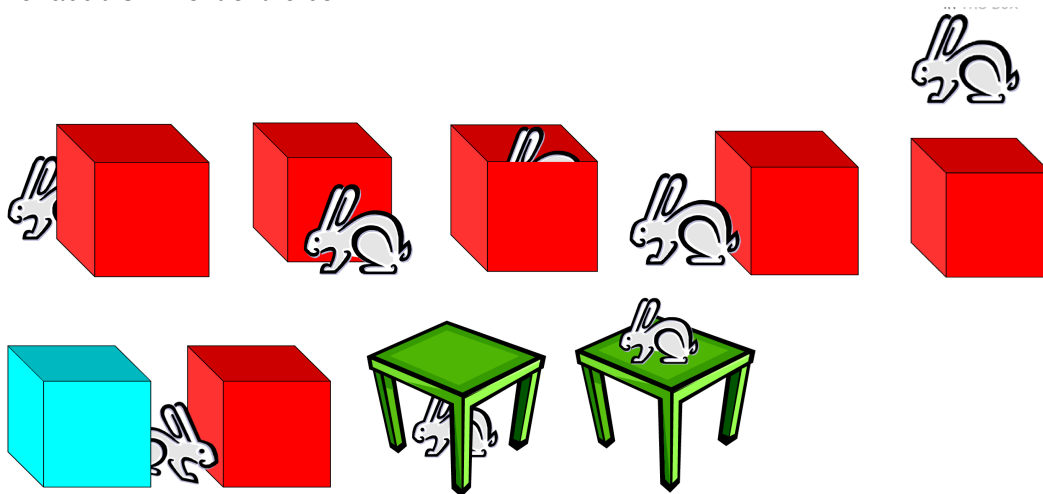

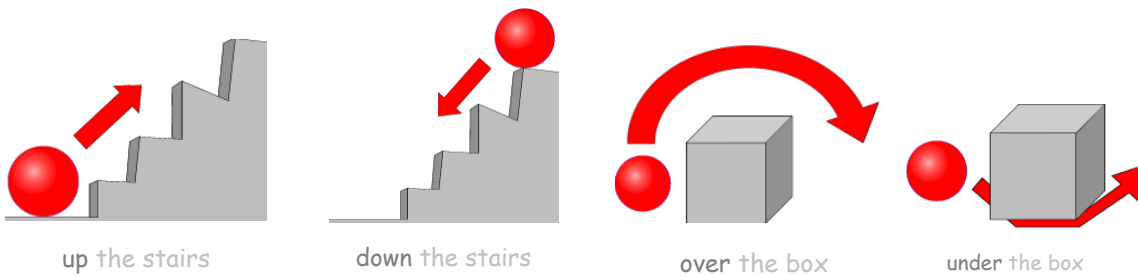
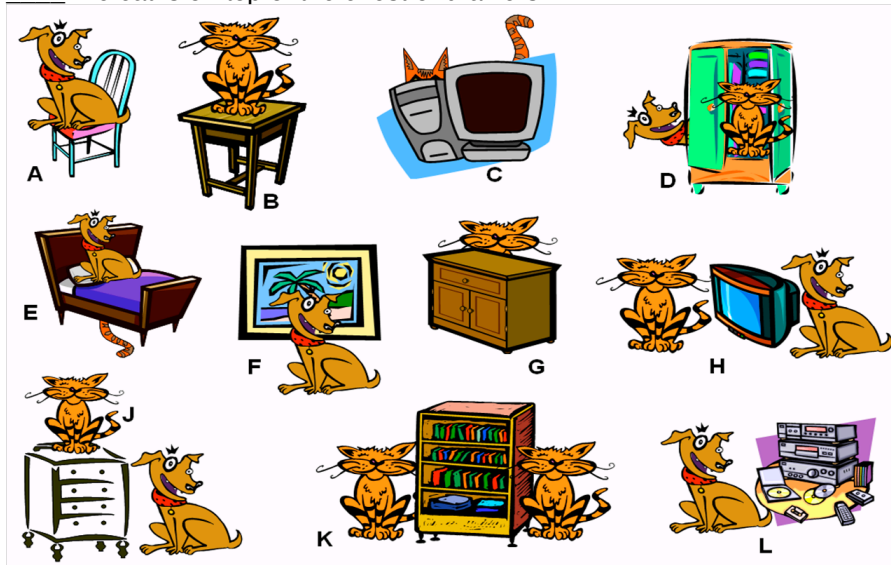

**Present Tense:**

The ball goes up the stairs. The ball goes down the stairs. The ball goes over the box. The ball goes under the box.

I go up the stairs. I go down the stairs. I go over the box. I go under the box.

**Past Tense:**

The ball went up the stairs. The ball went down the stairs. The ball went over the box. The ball went under the box.

I went up the stairs. I went down the stairs. I went over the box. I went under the box.

**Present Tense:**

I walk up the stairs. I walk down the stairs. The dog walks up the stairs. The dog walks down the stairs. I jump over the box. The bug runs under the box.

**Past Tense:**

I walked up the stairs. I walked down the stairs. The dog walked up the stairs. The dog walked down the stairs.

I jumped over the box. The bug ran under the box.
