I am doing my homework.

Past Continuous

I was doing well in English class. Now I am not doing well.

You were doing a good job.

We were doing fine. But now we are sick.

Future

I will do your homework.

You will do better tomorrow.

She will do all the housework.

They will do the dishes.

Example: do + want

Do you want to go? I do want to go, but I can't.

In this example, you can also say, "I want to go, but I can't." The "do" provides emphasis in this sentence, but it is not needed.
