Sara is very quiet. She doesn't laugh much. She likes to read books about science and study her lessons. She does not like to tell jokes or talk loudly.

Is Sara loud?

Does Sara like to tell jokes?

Does Sara talk quietly?

Sara is a serious person. Sara likes to do quiet things. She likes to read and study.

Ella is a fun-loving person. She likes to go to parties. She likes going out and meeting people. She likes adventure. She rides her mountain bike. She goes to theme parks. Ella rides roller coasters.

Does Ella enjoy going out?

Does Ella enjoy adventure?

What does Ella ride at theme parks?

Are you a serious person or a fun-loving person?

What adventures do you enjoy?

Jim is scared of many things. He does not like to go outside. He is afraid of dogs. He is afraid of bad weather. He is afraid he will get hurt. He does not take chances. Jim is afraid.

Do "scared" and "afraid" mean the same?

Does Jim like to go outside?

Does Jim like dogs?

Are you afraid of dogs?

Are you afraid of bad weather?

Are you afraid you will get hurt?

What things are you afraid of?

Bob saw a child fall in the river. He jumped in the river. The river was dangerous, but Bob was not afraid. Bob saved the child. Bob is brave.

Was Bob afraid?

Did Bob save the child?

Is Bob brave?

Are you brave?

Mary is a teacher. She teaches first grade. She loves the children. She helps the children learn to read. The children love Mary. She is nice.

Alice is a housewife. She does not like people. She does not want children playing in her yard. She might hit people who come in her yard. Alice is mean.

Who is the nicest person?

The man is loud. He sings loudly.

This man says, "be quiet". He does not like loud noise.

Some people like to listen to loud music. Do you like loud music?

The class starts at 9 o'clock. The teacher waits for the student. The student is late. He is always late.
