

**Come**

A. You can come in or come out. Ex: When someone knocks at your door, say "come in".  
When the children are in the house and you are outside, you say, "come out and play". You put your card in an ATM and money comes out.

B. You can come into a room. You can come inside. You can come back (return to the same place). You can come over. Ex: Come over to my house on Thursday. "Come on" means hurry up.

C. How come? means Why is that?

Example:

John: I can't come to your party.

Jess: How come?

John: My mother is arriving that day.

D. You can come for something.

Example:

Jane: There is a man at the door.

Ann: Yes, I called a delivery man. He came for the package. It is by the door. Please give it to him.

E. Present perfect of "come" is "have come". Ex: We have come to the end of the road. She has come to stay with her daughter.

**Go:**

A. You can go out, go up, go down, go to, go with

Examples:

Let's go out tonight. I don't want to cook.

Go up the stairs and turn left.

He went down the street to catch the express bus.

We went to the grocery store.

They went with Mother.

B. For activities you use go + ing verb.

Examples:

go swimming, go shopping, go dancing, go fishing, go skiing, go skating

C. Use go for future plans

Examples:

I am going to move to Dallas.

We are going to meet Sam for lunch.

They are going to stay at our house.

Sara went dancing.

Let's go fishing.

D. Past tense of go is "went". For present perfect tense we use have gotten. Ex: He has gotten his test scores. They have gotten a puppy.

**Have**

A. You can have:

trouble, a good trip, time, problems, trouble, a brother, a cold, a cup of coffee, a party, a baby, a meeting, a test, a snack, a broken arm, a headache and many more things.

B. "Have to" means must. Ex: I have to go home now. I have to study.

C. You "don't have to" if you have a choice.

Examples:

I don't have to go to work on Saturday. But I will because I need the money.  
I don't have to do the homework. The teacher says it is extra credit.  
You don't have to wash those dishes. I will do them later.  
We don't have to go dancing if you don't want to.

**Take**

- A. You can use take with time. Ex: It takes twenty minutes to get to work.
- B. You can use take with buses and trains. Ex: I take the bus to work. I take the train from Round Rock to downtown.
- C. You can use take with classes and tests. Ex: I take my final exam this week. I am taking classes in English.
- D. You can take something with you. Ex: Take some sunscreen to the beach. Take your camera on vacation.
- E. You can take someone's picture, take medicine for a cold, take a shower, take a nap.
- F. Present perfect tense is "have taken". Ex: I have taken her to the doctor.
