**Increase your vocabulary:**

**attend:** If you attend a meeting, you go to it. EX: We attend the University of Texas. The children will not attend the party. Attend can also mean to take care of. EX: The nurse will attend to the patients in the hospital. When used in this way, attend is always followed by "to".

The **attendance** at an event is the number of people that attend. In public schools, teachers take attendance every morning. That means they count the number of students who are attending. An **attendant** is someone whose job is to serve people. The attendant checked my tires.

Question: Make a list of things that are usually done by an attendant.

**attract**: cause to come near EX: The magnet attracts iron. The flowers attract bees. Her performances attract large audiences. A pretty woman attracts attention.

An **attraction** is something that makes people want to come. EX: Disney World is America's top tourist attraction.

**Attractive** is an adjective describing someone or something that is nice to look at. EX: She is an attractive woman. His new couch is very attractive.

Question: Tell about places in your country that attract tourists.

**avoid**: keep away from EX: I avoid crowds. Try to avoid overeating on holidays. He stepped on the brakes to avoid hitting the dog. I think Sara is avoiding me.

When you try not to do something, you say that you avoid doing it, not that you "avoid to do it".

Question: Talk about things you avoid doing.

**accompany**: to go with EX: My mother accompanied me to the theatre. All children must be accompanied by an adult. Color photographs accompany the text. The pianist accompanied the singers.

Question: Does your spouse accompany you when you go shopping?
