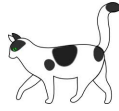


Go means to move from one place to another. Look at the examples.



The children go to school.



The cat goes outside.



That man goes fast.



They go to the playground.

Infinitive “to go”

Go + ing verbs

Read these sentences one at a time and then together.

5. We go swimming with John.
6. They go fishing every day.

Go in questions. Notice in questions, you separate the helping verb from the main verb "go". Ex: I should go. Should I go? I am going. Are you going?
