



A. Look at the car ads.

An ad is an advertisement. You advertise something you want to sell. Advertisement or ad is a noun. To advertise is a verb. Example: I advertised my car in the paper. This means you paid for a message telling your car is for sale.

The man wants to buy a car. He looks at ads in the paper. What do the ads in the paper say?

A compact car is a very small car. A sedan is a larger car. It often has four doors. Which kind of car would you prefer?

B. Ask the seller about the car.

See the car. It has a "for sale" sign in the window. What color is the car?  
The man talks to the seller. What does the man ask?

C. Take the car to a mechanic.

A mechanic repairs cars. Why does the man take the car to a mechanic?  
What does the mechanic say?

D. Negotiate a price.

Negotiate means bargain. You discuss the price. The seller wants one price. You want a lower price. Finally you agree at one price. This is negotiation. If you get a good price, it is a bargain.

E. Get the title from the seller.

The title says you own the car. You must have a title to your car. The man bought the car. The seller gave him the title. Now he is the owner of the car.

F. Register the car.

You register the car at the Department of Motor Vehicles. You get a registration sticker for your windshield. You will have to pay a fee.

G. Fill the tank with gas.

The man is pumping gas into his car. Gas is expensive.

H. Check the oil.

The man puts a stick in. It will show how much oil is in the engine. You must have oil in the engine.

I. Put in coolant.

Coolant makes the engine run cool. A hot engine is bad. A cool engine runs well. The man adds coolant.

J. Go for a smog check.

This is an emissions test. Emissions is what comes out of the car. Emissions are dangerous. Someone should check the emissions on your car.

K. Replace the windshield wipers.

Windshield wipers clean your windshield. They keep rain off the windshield. This man puts new wiper blades on.

L. Fill the tires with air.

Inflate the tires. That means put air in them. This man is inflating his tires.
