*A policy requiring students to wear uniforms is a bad idea for several reasons. First, no style of clothing looks good on everyone. Teenagers are especially sensitive about their appearance. Forcing them to wear clothing that doesn't fit properly or flatter them is bad for their fragile self-esteem. In addition, uniforms are expensive.*

*Students have to have several sets of uniforms for laundering. Because most students won't wear their uniforms after school, they will still have to buy normal clothes. Furthermore, many students are growing so fast at this time, that they will outgrow their uniforms during the school year. This would mean purchasing a second set of uniforms. Finally, teenagers are mature enough to make their own decisions. Making all students dress the same destroys the students sense of individuality. The world should not force uniforms on students, but let them express their unique personality through their clothing.*
