Question-- Tell me about your job. Tell me about your family. Tell me about your apartment.
Compliment--That is a nice purse. I love your shoes. Your necklace is very pretty.

How to make an apology

I'm sorry. I'm sorry I am late. I am sorry I stepped on your foot. Pardon me. Excuse me.

What to say when someone apologizes to you:

That's OK.
That's all right.
You don't need to apologize.
Don't worry about it.
I understand.

English is hard.
The teachers here are mean.
I like the students.
I live alone.
I ride the bus.

Accept or Decline an Invitation

Will you come to my party? Yes, I will. I accept your invitation.
Will you come to my party? No, I can't. I must decline your invitation. I will be out of town.
