**Intro** means within or inward

**Extro** means outward

An **extrovert** is a person who is out-going. They like to be around people. They are very social. Extroverts are often the life of the party. They seem confident of their abilities.

If you **oppose** something, you are against it. If you **obstruct** something, you keep it from happening. If something is **obsolete**, it is out of date and therefore no longer used.
