FEELING (*noun*) 1: an emotional state or reaction. [*I don't want to hurt her feelings.*] 2: a belief. [*He had the feeling he was being watched.*] 3: the capacity to experience the sense of touch. [*A loss of feeling in his hand*]

ROOT: "to feel"
