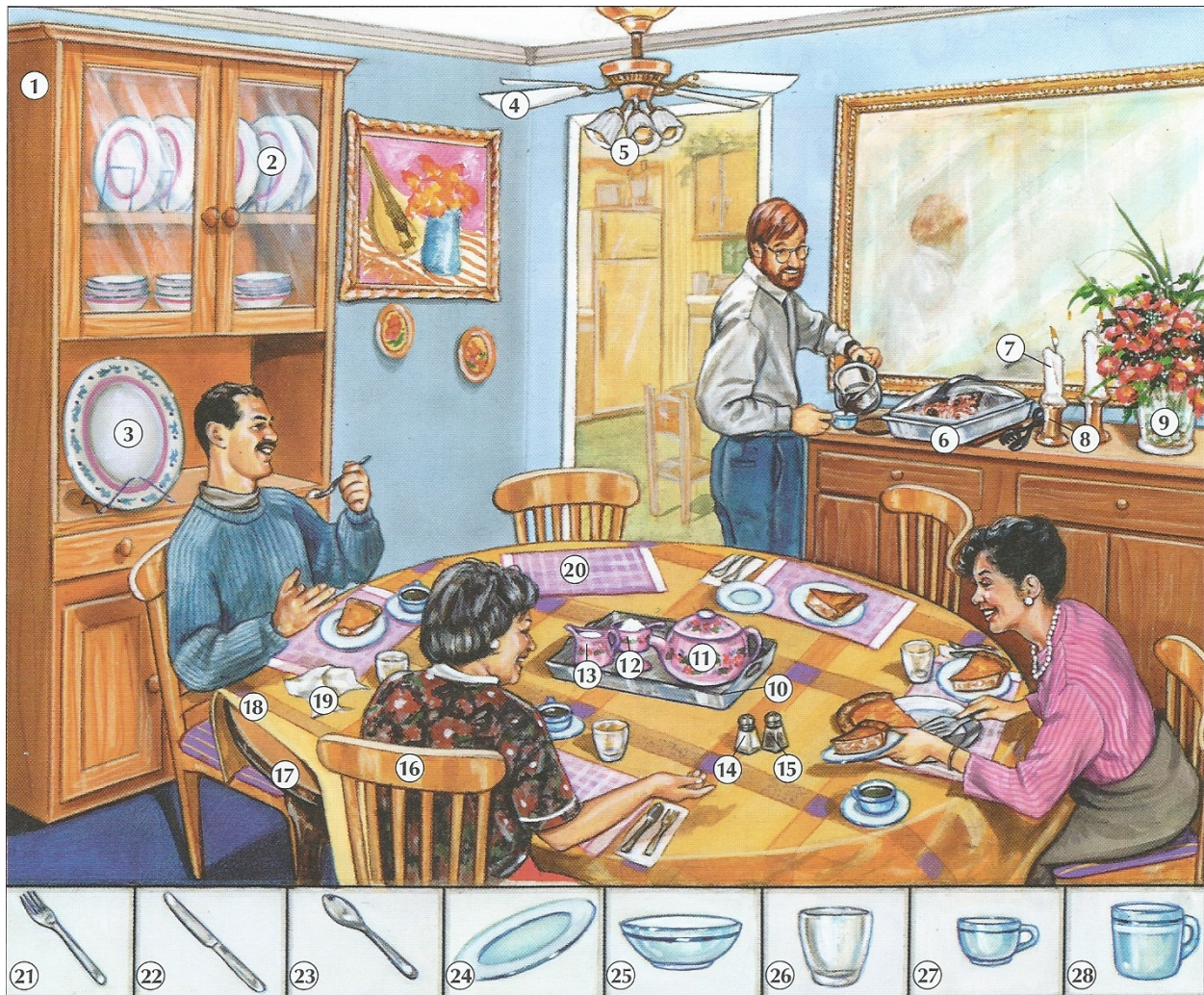


1. Label all the items below.
