Dialogs

The problem Dialog 1	<p>Sasha: Thanks for taking me to work today. I'm tired of riding the bus. Joe: You should get a drivers license. Sasha: Is it hard to pass the test? Joe: The test isn't hard, but it I was afraid of driving in Austin at first. Sasha: We have a lot of traffic and the streets are very confusing. Joe: Yeah, I got lost many times before I learned how to get around town. Sasha: I need to study for the test and practice driving. Joe: I'll help you. We can practice in the Highland Mall parking lot in my car.</p>
Practice Dialog 2	<p>Joe: Go slowly. Drive to that light and turn left. Sasha: OK. Do you want me to use my turn signal? Joe: Yes, you should practice that. Sasha: Am I going too fast? Joe: No, this is fine. That was a good turn. You seem comfortable. Sasha: Yeah, this isn't too hard. Joe: Park over there. Try to get between the lines. Sasha: Did I do OK? Joe: Let's get out and look. Sasha: No, I parked over the line. I'll back up and try again.</p>
The Car Dialog 3	<p>Joe: How did you do? Sasha: I passed my test! I got my license! Joe: Congratulations! Sasha: Tomorrow I am going shopping for a car. Joe: What kind of car do you want? Sasha: Something safe that gets good gas mileage. And something cheap. I don't have a lot of money. Joe: Do you want a 2-door car or a 4-door car. Sasha: I really want an SUV, but that will be too expensive. I'll probably get a 4-door car. Maybe a Honda or a Toyota. Joe: I think Chris wants to sell his white Corolla. You should call him. Sasha: That is a good idea.</p>
