Pronunciation: Here are a few English pronunciation rules. BUT remember that there are many exceptions.

C followed by i, e or y usually has the soft S sound. EX: city, central, cyst

G followed by i, e or y usually has the J sound. EX: gym, gem, gist

When a syllable has 2 vowels together, the first vowel is usually long and the second is silent. Examples: "pain, eat, boat, res/cue, say, grow".

NOTE: Diphthongs don't follow this rule; In a diphthong, the vowels blend together to create a single new sound. The diphthongs are: "oi,oy,ou,ow,au,aw, oo" and many others.

"OO" words can be pronounced with a long sound like "soon" or a short sound like "wood".

In some words “cie” makes the “sh” sound. EX: ancient, efficient, conscious
