### Should, Would, Could

Should is used to give advice: "You should wear that shirt because it makes you look thinner." Could is used to ask permission: "Could I borrow that shirt for a party tonight?" Would is used when referring to an a situation that may or may not happen: "I really like your shirt. Would you give it to me?"
