

Review the OPD page 106, then discuss these questions.

1. What body part do you injure most often?
2. Which of your senses is the most important, sight, hearing, taste, touch or smell? Which would you hate to lose the most?
3. Do you like to wear perfume or cologne to make yourself smell good?
4. Do you wear glasses or contacts? How long have you worn them?
5. If you “finger” something, you touch it. If I said, “Don’t finger the merchandise (things I have for sale), I mean don’t touch it. Do you like to finger the clothes before you buy them?
6. Where is your torso? Where are your limbs?
7. Where is your shin? Point to your calf and thigh.
8. Point to your palm, wrist, knuckle and forearm.
9. Nod your head. Did you know “head” can also be a verb. You can head to the store. It means to go towards a place.
10. If someone “eyes” you, they stare at you. EX: The lion in the zoo eyed me from behind the bars.
11. Shrug your shoulders. What does that gesture mean?
12. Your food is digested in your stomach. But we can use “stomach” as a verb. EX: Dan always insults my friends. I can’t stomach his behavior.
13. Point to your knee. Demonstrate “kneeling”.
14. Mouth can be a verb. EX: The song was played through the speakers and the singers only mouthed the words. (appeared to sing the words, but with no sound coming out.)
15. Where is the small of your back? Do you ever have backaches? If you “back out” of something, you decide not to do it. Have you ever backed out of something you planned to do?



Work with a partner:

Study these body parts. Have your partner point to something on his/her face. You tell what body part that is.

- Where is the bridge of your nose?
- Where is your scalp?
- Do you have a part in your hair?
- Do you have a receding hairline?
- Where is the nape of your neck?
- Do you have sideburns?
