

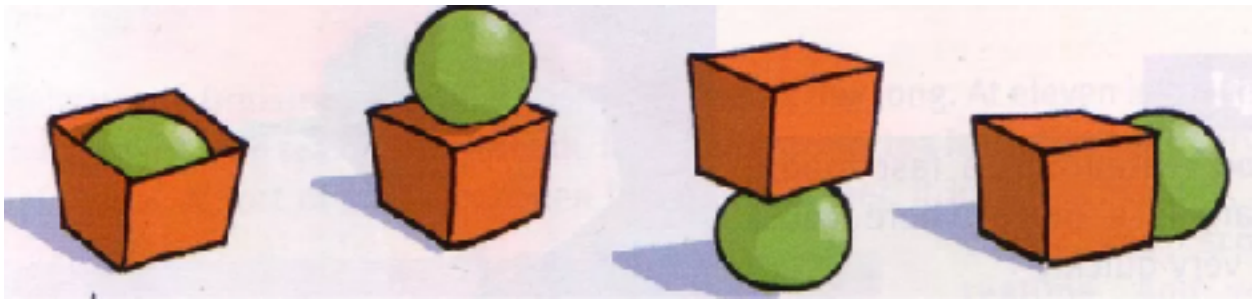

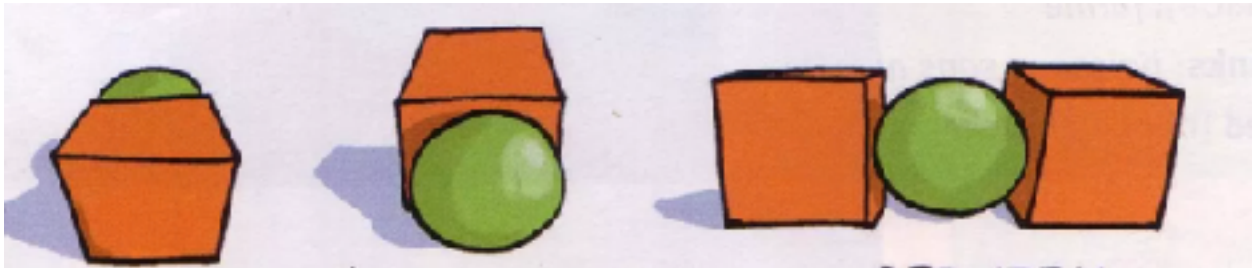

Prepositions of Time: on, in, at.

Use ON for: days of the week (on Monday) calendar dates (on August 30th), special days (on my birthday) weekend (on the weekend)

Use IN for: months and seasons (in spring, in August), year (in 2018), period of the day (in the morning, in the afternoon BUT at night), a certain period of time (in a minute, in two hours)

Use AT for: night (at night), a precise time (at 9 o'clock)

Other prepositions of time:

by- at the latest EX: I will call you by 5PM. I will leave by 9 o'clock.

for - over this period EX: I lived in Japan for 2 years. I will stay here for three months.

before - earlier than this EX: I studied English before I came here. I lived in Italy before I came here.

since - from then to now EX: I have lived here since June. It has not rained since July.

ago - at this past point EX: I moved here two months ago.
