

We can show emotion by the way we breathe.

gasp: breathe in suddenly because you are surprised or in pain. EX: She gasped when she realized there was someone following them. She grabbed her husband's arm.

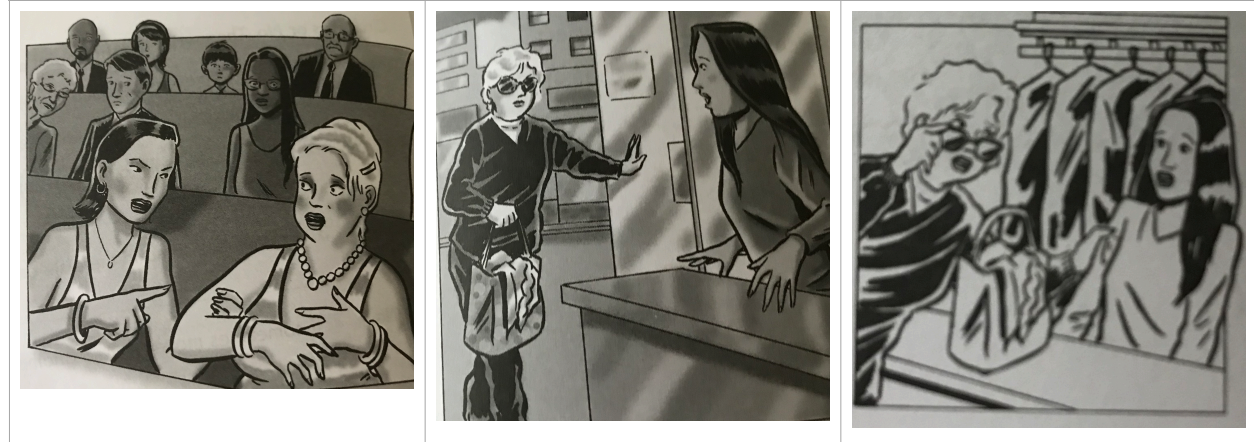
groan: make a long deep sound because you are in pain or unhappy about something EX: The children groaned when the teacher gave them more homework. He held his broken arm and groaned.

sigh: breathe out loudly and slowly to express emotion. EX: We knew Mother was tired because she sighed as she got out of her chair. He sighed and shook his head when he learned someone had hit his new car.
