Using the verb HAVE: I have, you have, he has, she has, we have, they have

We use HAVE to mean we possess something or own something.

Past tense of HAVE is HAD.

Have can be the main verb in the sentence. Read these examples.

1. I have twenty dollars.
2. I don't have time to make my bed.
3. They have a nice apartment.
4. She has two dogs and a cat.
5. He has the flu.
6. The deer has large antlers.

7. We have a meeting at 9.
8. Jon had a party last night.
9. I have a new car.
10. Have a seat. The doctor will see you soon.
11. We had an apartment in Dallas.
12. They had fun at the restaurant.
13. I had breakfast with Mom.
14. She has an appointment with the doctor tomorrow.

HAVE can be used as a helping verb in present perfect tense. Read these examples.

1. Bill has come to Austin to study.
2. I have bought a new dress.
3. We have eaten all the food.
4. You have won the prize.
5. She has felt bad all day.

You can use have as a helping verb in present continuous tense. Read these examples

1. I am having a baby.
2. We are having trouble finding an apartment.
3. The children are having a good time.
4. What are you having for dinner?
5. I am having soup for dinner.
