

**FUMC ESL 10-17-2024 Lower Level Lesson**

**Introduce yourself. Tell where you are from and where you live now. Tell something about yourself.**

**Infinitives: Infinitives are phrases that begin with TO and have a verb afterwards.** EX: I want to go home. The infinitive is "to go". Want is the main verb in the sentence.

Read these sentences. Tell what the infinitive is and what the main verb is.

1. Jess wants to see the new movie.
2. Sandy loves to work in her garden.
3. Jim refuses to talk in class.
4. Jan hates to shop for shoes.
5. They can't afford to buy a car.
6. The children learned to spell their names.

8. She agreed to babysit our children.

**Not all infinitives use TO. Read these examples.**

- 1-She lets her dog sleep on the bed. NOT She lets her dog to sleep on the bed.
- 2-The doctor made us wait for an hour. NOT The doctor made us to wait for an hour.
- 3-She helped us understand the lesson. NOT She helped us to understand the lesson.
