An Honest Man

Daniel is at a restaurant. He is having lunch alone. He feels something on the floor near his foot. Daniel looks under the table. There is a wallet with \$120 in cash. There is also a credit card in the wallet. Daniel looks for identification. He finds a driver's license. The driver's license belongs to Laura Sanders. The address on the driver's license is very close to the restaurant. Daniel puts the wallet on the table and finishes his meal.

1. Who is Daniel having lunch with?
2. What does Daniel find under the table?
3. What does Daniel do with the wallet?
4. What are some things you can do when you find someone's wallet?

Daniel leaves the restaurant. He finds the house that matches the address on the license. He knocks on the door. A beautiful woman answers the door. Daniel says, "I'm looking for Laura Sanders." The woman says, "I am Laura Sanders." Daniel gives her the wallet. He explains how he found the wallet.

1. What does Daniel do after he finishes his meal?
2. Who answers the door?
3. What does Daniel explain?

Laura is very happy. She opens her wallet. All the cash is there and her credit card is there. She says, "Let me give you a \$40 reward for returning my wallet. Daniel tells her he doesn't want a reward. Laura says, "Thank you so much. You are a very honest man. I want to do something for you." Daniel says, "Please let me take you to lunch this Saturday. We can meet at the restaurant where you lost your wallet." Laura says, "OK, but I will pay for lunch."

1. Why does Laura check her wallet?
2. What does Laura want to give Daniel?
3. What does Daniel want instead of a reward?
4. What does Laura say about the lunch?

5. Do you think it would have been more **appropriate** for Daniel to turn the lost wallet into the restaurant manager instead of going to Laura's home? Would you have answered the door if a stranger came to your door? What do you think Daniel would have done if no one answered the door at Laura's house?
6. Have you ever left something important in a restaurant or other location? Did someone return it to you or did you recover it yourself?

Discussions With Feelings Vocabulary:

1-inspired / inspiring: when you are stimulated to create something or do something. EX: After listening to the teacher's speech at parent's night, I was **inspired** to volunteer in the school. EX: The teacher gave an **inspiring** speech. EX: Listening to the six year old play the guitar **inspired** me to take guitar lessons. I felt like if a child could learn to play, so could I.

Talk about a time you felt inspired. What was the result of your inspiration? How do you inspire others?

2-furious or livid-when you are extremely angry. EX: The teacher made me furious when she accused me of cheating on the exam. EX: The movie star was livid that she didn't get a part in the movie.

Describe a time when you were furious about something. What did you do about it?

3-anxious / anxiety: when you are afraid and uncertain about something. EX: I was so anxious about the flight that I couldn't fall asleep. EX: I have anxiety any time I have to take a long flight.

Does flying make you anxious? What does make you anxious? What are you anxious about right now? Are you anxious when you have to speak English? What situations make you most anxious about your English? Are you more or less anxious than your spouse? What do you do to relieve your anxiety?

4-delighted / delightful-when something happens that gives you great pleasure. EX: I was delighted to hear I won the scholarship and would be able to attend college. EX: I had a wonderful time with Jim. He is a delightful man. EX: Dinner was delightful.

What kinds of things delight you? Give an example of something delightful that happened to you or someone you know.

5-intrigued / intriguing: When you are extremely curious about or interested in something. EX: I am intrigued about space travel. EX: I find space travel an intriguing subject to study.

Do you ever wonder if there is life on other planets? Are you intrigued about politics? Talk about what intrigues you?
