

**Vowels can make unusual sounds:**

1-For example, the letters EI together sometimes have the long A sound. Say these words: ***weigh, weight, neighbor, eight, eighty, eighteen, freight, sleigh, vein, veil, rein, beige***. Can you hear the long A sound?

2- OO sounds like a long U. Say these words: ***pool, school, tool, broom, soon, tooth, root***  
But sometimes OO sounds a little like a short U: ***book, took, good, look, wood***

3- OW can sound like long O: ***row, tow, low, blow, show, window, shadow*** OR it can sound like ***cow, now, how, allow, down***.

4-"***One***" sounds like wun and "***other***" sounds like uther.

5-"***Shoe***", "***View***", "***Two***", "***Argue***" and "***Chew***" all rhyme. The vowel sound is the same.
